

RACC Adult Community Learning Wellbeing Courses Self-Declaration

Courses marked with ☺ or a star in the course guide or online are for adults looking for health and wellbeing opportunities. RACC has created a concessionary rate on these courses. This gives a 50% discount to learners who are on a household income below £27,000, and who self-declare that they have a learning difficulty, disability, mental health difficulty, are unemployed, are carers, or aged 65+ living alone. There is a 25% concession for anyone over 70, regardless of household income.
